




















WELL STRUCTURED FUNCTIONAL

Silvopasture

Potential for cropping forest products while continuing the grazing enterprise.

Restoring soil structure - fungal soil biology - improving infiltration

Powerful tree roots break through soil horizons, cycling water and minerals deep in the soil.



The Aftermath

Disturbance created with grazing management is used - to simulate pasture as the understory

Short duration grazing events lead to little or no tree damage

Cycling minerals building soil humus and fertility
