<u>Afforestation Programme Supports For Agroforestry</u>

- Silvopastoral Systems (FT 8 was GPC 11)
- Silvoarable Systems (Pilot, measure)
- Forest Gardening (Pilot measure)



Design Things to consider

Rows – Headlands, Machinery, shape of field. Three tree species, in groups of three.

Groups – Headlands, Barbed wire ? Bull wire electrified. Sheep ?

Singly – 5 x 5 metre spacing tight for machinery. Okay for grazing.

Native Tree Area Scheme will be paid at FT1 and FT2 rates. Premiums will be paid over 10 years rather than 20 at a rate of €2,206 per ha annually for NTA1 and €2,284 per ha annually for NTA2

Additional payment of €1,000 per ha will be paid to landowner on completion of planting

** Grant includes Trails, Seats & Signage Facilities and Derelict Site payment

Grant includes Facilities payment





Agroforestry FT8 Silvopasture General Points

- Was GPC 11 now FT8
- Minimum 400 trees/ha, will be thinned over time to circa 150 trees/ha.
- Sites need to be well drained a minimum of 0.5 ha.
- Objectives will depend on the land owner grazing, silage, hay or all of them.
- Single and Rows good for sheep. Groups for cattle.
- Integrating the trees as much as possible within fields.
 - -Quality timber, multispecies swards, improved animal welfare.



Agroforestry FT8 Silvopasture General Points cont.

- Improved drainage and water retention.
- Species are not confined to native species. Recommend Oak, Cherry, sycamore,
 Norway Maple. 10-15% Birch/Alder. 15% Fruit and nut.
- Cultivation Pit plant, Use an Auger, Rip, shallow invert mound.
- No spraying , use manual cleaning.
- No industrial fertilizer. Can use slurry (not from intensive pig or poultry farms)



Post and Shelter

- 1. TUBEX tree shelter 1.5 metres tall, use <u>wire</u> ties, remove plastic ties.
- 2. Round post, 1.5 metres tall, 7cm diameter.
- 3. Square post, 1.5 metres tall, 7cm diameter Or

Half round, 1.5 metres tall, 13-17cm wide, 6 cm thick in middle.

One Page Plan

- Ground Preparation
- Species (fruit and nut trees)
- Design (Single, Rows, Groups)
- Stocking (400/hectare)
- Protection (shelters/fencing)
- Maintenance (Shaping/veg.control)
- Grazing (animal type)
- RUS (stumps, drains, reseeding)



Each plot Stock fenced, e.g. for 1ha



Woodland Improvement Scheme

€1,200 /ha

- Replace Tubes with Geotextile mesh.
- Remove or replace second post.
- Formative shaping.

Maintenance

- Check Tubes not being crushed/damaged.
- Fill in dead plants.
- Pull vegetation out from inside the shelters.
- Do shelters need to be removed, new protection needed?
- Shaping.
- Disease, pest damage etc.



Agroforestry Payments (Silvopasture)

Grants – Old rate € 5,620/ha, New rate € 8,555/ha
These figures do not include fencing rates.

Premiums – Old rate € 645/ha, New rate € 975/ha

Premium duration – old rate 5 years, new rate 10 years

(for farmer and non farmer)



Silvoarable Systems Pilot

Growing crops amongst trees (mostly rows)



Cereals



Fruit



Vegetables



Silvoarable Specs/Pilot

- Pilot measure, 30 ha/year, 4 projects/year,
- Grant €6000, Prem. € 829/year for 10 years,
- 20% Fruit & Nut trees
- Initial plan/layout. Widths multiples of 3 metres.
- No shelters needed, not grazed, may require rabbit protection.
- Headlands essential, guidance for machine operators.
- General conditions same as silvopasture.
- Accepting applications now.



3. Forest Gardening



Forest Gardens are probably the worlds oldest form of land use and most resilient agroecosystem. Pioneered by Robert Hart in the 1980s in the UK.



Forest Garden Pilot

- Pilot measure, 6ha/year, 1ha plots.
- Grant €6000, Prem. € 829/year for 10 years.
- 40% Fruit & Nut trees.
- Initial plan/layout.
- No shelters needed, not grazed.
- General conditions same as silvopasture.
- Accepting applications now.





Ash die back – RUS scheme

- 1, One page plan.
- 2, Stump Removal is not mandatory.
- 3, Consider mound drains and reseeding.





Organic Payments

- Land classified as agroforestry.
- 5 year scheme.
- €2,000/ha for the first year of conversion.
- €1,400/ha thereafter.



Potential Payments

Land classified as forestry/agroforestry.

Trees protected under the 2014 forestry act.

- 10 year Forestry premium payments
- 5 year Organic payments
- Biss Payments





Land classified as Agriculture Agri-Climate Rural Environment Scheme

- Creation of Traditional Orchards
- Planting trees in riparian zones
- Tree planted singly, rows or groups
 (>0.1 ha and < 1.0 ha, 300 trees)
- Tree belts for Ammonia capture

ECO scheme

Agricultural Measure

- 5 year scheme, Agricultural Practice 4
- Plant 3 trees or 1 metre of hedge/ha
- or 6 trees /ha enhanced option.
- €60 to €65 /ha
- Parkland trees
